After losing her own son, she adopted Shivalingappa and made him the heir to the throne. The British did not accept this and ordered expulsion of Shivlingappa. The Rani defied the order and was the first lady who fought against the British with great courage and skill. She could not hold out for long and was taken captive and lodged in Bailhogal Fort, where she died in 1829. Rani Chennamma's determination to fight against all odds is what inspires the members of this house to overcome all hurdles.

Tagore House (Blue House)

CODE OF CONDUCT

Kalpavruksha model school is committed to developing conscientious and sel disciplined learners who will be trend setters. We want students to inculcate goo(manners and develop decision making problem solving, effecting communication ant inter personal skills that would enable them to deal with the demands and challenges o everyday life. Any disruptive activities that would mar the image of the school or hinder the growth of students as morally and socially upright individuals would be unacceptable.

The following practices will lead to strict disciplinary action.

- 1 disfiguring or damaging school property.
- 2 scribbling or writing anyting on the walls, furniture or uniform.
- 3 Damaging, scribbling or tearing pages from library books, texts or exercise books.
- 4 Bringing sharp and injury causing articles such as knives etc.
- 5 Bringing books, CDs etc not relevant to their course of work.
- 6 Bringing costly articles like expensive watches, cameras, fountain pens, cell phones etc.
- 7 wearing expensive gold / precious jewellery.
- 8 Bullying or using any form of violence against fellow student and using abusive language.
- 9 Bursting crackers or throwing colour on one another within the school premises.
- 10 Late arrival in school.
- 11 Misconduct, indiscipline and misbehavior in school buses.
- 12 Speaking in any other lanage besides English within the school premises .

The Following disciplinary measures may be adopted, if necessary.

(A)verbal warning and counseling (B)written warning

Attendance:

Coming to School regularly is an integral part student's life. You must also make sure that you reach school by 8:20 am. This inculcates discipline and regularity in a student which in turn creates value systems that become an essential part of life there is no substitute for the holistic education gained by a child in the school environment. No student will be allowed to enter class without a leave application, if s /he has been absent the previous day. Prior intimation is necessary for leave. No leave beyond 5 to 10 days will be granted except on medical grounds.

Leave of absence.

- 1. Students who have been sick for more than five days will bring a medical certificates form their doctor on rejoining school.
- it is compulsory for all students to maintain at least 75% attendance during the course of the academic session to enable them to appear for the final examination. The percentage however could be relaxed on medical grounds.
- 3. Students absent for examination without medical certificate will be marked absent in the report sheet.
